Our Cuban plant has been quoted the following prices on  
Lithopone and Loaded Zinc from Europe.

Titanium Dioxide (Anatase) similar to Titanox - A;  
\$20.00 per 100 Lbs. CIF Havana (from Bayer, Germany)  
This is equal to a U.S. price of \$18.40 FAS Eastern Port.

Titanium Dioxide (Rutile) - similar to Titanox RANC;  
\$22.00 per 100 Lbs. CIF Havana (from Bayer, Germany)  
This is equal to a U.S. price of \$20.40 FAS Eastern Port.

Loaded Zinc Oxide 65/35 (65% ZnO); of German origin  
\$9.65 per 100 Lbs. CIF Havana (from "Lithos", Holland)  
This is equal to a U.S. price of \$9.10 FAS Southern Port.

Loaded Zinc Oxide 92/8 (92% ZnO); of German origin  
\$9.95 per 100 lbs. CIF Havana (from "Lithos", Holland)  
This is equal to a U.S. price of \$8.40 FAS Southern Port.

Lithopone (regular 30% ZnS grade)  
\$7.00 per 100 Lbs. CIF Havana (from Bayer, Germany or  
"Lithos", Holland). This is equal to a U.S. price of  
\$5.50 FAS Southern Port.

Inasmuch as this looks to me as though they are below the metal  
values content in the pigments, I cannot believe they are any good.  
However I have asked Dick Steudel to have Bill Heland send you samples  
as soon as possible for checking and I would appreciate hearing from  
you later on it.
