ANALYSIS OF DELAWARE RIVER FISH SAMPLES
FOR TRACE METALS

Enclosed please find the results of trace metal analyses in fish and the field sheets for fish collection during March, April and May 1972.

The methods of analysis were comparable to those reported earlier by Miss Adele Pochomis, except that samples were dried at 100°C for 16 hours prior to digestion and analysis. The concentration of trace metals both on wet weight as well as on dry weight basis is tabulated (Table 1).

A detailed report, as per our discussion on the telephone, concerning trace metal analysis in fish during June 1971 - May 1972, will be submitted shortly.
