Statement of Complaint: Excessively rolls of asbestos are being stored in Dept. 7810 at J-19 next to the Pyrometer Crib. This asbestos is being rolled, unrolled, cut and grinded on creating an unsafe and hazardous condition with the asbestos fibers in the air. ~~HEALTH~~ These fibers in general create a health hazard, anytime the asbestos is worked with.

Adjustment Requested: The Union requests that this asbestos be stored elsewhere, preferably in an enclosed space or an isolated area. Another alternative is that a substitute material be used instead of asbestos.

Results of Discussion with Foreman: G. Foreman Tourville was spoken to about this problem and stated that this asbestos is rarely used or worked with. This minimal use he felt did not jeopardize any of the employees working nearby.
