- NPMA will monitor EPA social media and more actively assist in promoting EPA efforts that coincide with NPMA priorities.
- Certification and Training – NPMA would be happy to work with EPA in building out timelines, resources and materials for the implementation of the final rule in May of 2018.
- Pyrethroids - EPA's draft human health and ecological risk assessments for the registration review are open for public comment until July 7th. NPMA has some concerns with the draft assessments and we will forward our comments to you when we've completed them.
