The 35th Annual Meeting of the Lead Industries Association, Inc. will be held jointly with the American Zinc Institute, Inc. at:

Chicago, Illinois
April 29-30 and May 1, 1963

The first day, Monday, April 29, will be devoted exclusively to the activities of the Lead Industries Association, Inc.

On Tuesday morning, April 30, a joint session will be held with the A.Z.I.

Tuesday afternoon, April 30, and Wednesday morning, May 1, will be devoted to activities of A.Z.I. L.I.A. members are also invited to attend, if they wish.

The two Monday sessions will include reports of the Expanded Research Program and of the L.I.A. staff, as well as consideration of certain amendments to the By-Laws which will be circulated to the membership prior to the meeting, and the election of directors. Also included will be papers on the outlook for and new developments in both old and new lead products.

At the joint L.I.A.-A.Z.I. session on the morning of Tuesday, April 30, papers will be presented on the world lead-zinc situation, the Washington situation as it affects lead and zinc, and the general trend of the U.S. economy.

The usual luncheons will be held on both days and Monday evening, April 29, will be devoted to the traditional L.I.A. cocktail party and reception.

Please note that preceding the formal Annual Meeting, there will be a Lead Technical Steering Committee meeting on Thursday, April 25, and a Lead Industry Development Committee meeting on Saturday, April 27. Those concerned will wish to take these into account in making hotel reservations. Interested parties may attend the Industry Development Committee meeting whether or not they are members of the committee; please inform us if you plan to attend so that arrangements may be made for an adequate meeting room.

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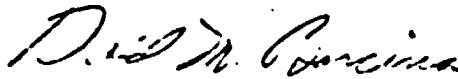
