At a recent conference in Washington with our Deputy Administrator, Mr. Walter A. Janssen, your President and Secretary endeavored to plan a program with the Deputy, which would expedite the approval of the Lead Code by the N. E. A.

Arrangements have been made to hold a preliminary, informal conference with the Deputy and his advisers, that is, representatives of labor, consumer and legal interests, in Washington on December 11. The Executive Committee is planning to attend this meeting.

Shortly after the preliminary conference, it is expected that the date for the public hearing will be definitely set, and it will be probably ten days to two weeks after the preliminary conference.
