Thanks for your letter of August 9th with the information concerning Mr. [REDACTED] of North Judson, Indiana. I think it would be wise if you were to have one of your representatives look into the matter promptly and report to us on his findings. I would suggest that you make it a point to specifically instruct your representative not to enter into any discussion or controversy, but merely to ascertain the facts. It is our general practice to conduct our investigations through the physician who is in charge of such a sick man. It would be well, therefore, to find out who this physician is and to find out from him whether the statements made in the letter are true. If you will then report the facts to us, we will investigate the case promptly.

I am returning the letters to you so that when you write again you will have all the available information to report.
