Abalone, Deer Bills Approved

SACRAMENTO, April 17 (AP)—All bills before the senate fish and game committee relating to the taking of catfish in Clear Lake were tabled yesterday with the expectation that proponents and opponents of commercial fishing for the species will be able to reach an agreement.

The committee gave favorable recommendation to Senator Bigler's bill, placing a bag limit of 10 abalone a day on the Mendocino coast.

Favorable recommendation was given to Assemblyman Mayo's bill that divides the state into two instead of four districts for the hunting of deer and making the open season along the coast from Mendocino county to San Luis Obispo county from August 1 to September 15 and the remainder of the state from September 15 to October 15.



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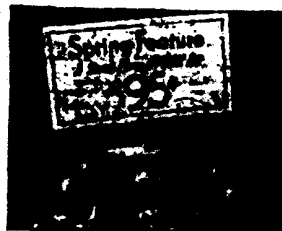
