Subject: Asbestos Exposures

All industrial hygiene records and study reports were reviewed to identify representative employees and job classifications where significant asbestos exposures were documented or could be reasonably expected to occur or had occurred. The attachment lists those where exposures to airborne asbestos fibers exceeded (individuals) or probably exceeded (job classifications) the 0.1 fiber per cubic centimeter OSHA asbestos standard medical monitoring action level.

After your review, it should be assured that all indicated are considered for medical monitoring.
