

FOUNDING OF THE A. S. H. V. E.

The organization of a Society of heating and ventilating engineers was first talked of by Hugh J. Barron and L. H. Hart in the early summer of 1894.

On August 2, 1894, a group of 15 men met at the office of *Heating and Ventilation*, 146 World Bldg., New York, and a committee of 5 was chosen to effect an organization.

The first meeting was called at 3:00 p.m., September 10, 1894, at the Broadway Central Hotel and temporary officers were elected: F. P. Smith, *Chairman*; and L. H. Hart, *Clerk*. The roll call showed that 75 persons had become Charter Members. It was voted that the name of the organization should be THE AMERICAN SOCIETY OF HEATING AND VENTILATING ENGINEERS and a Constitution and By-Laws were adopted.
