In order to complete our evaluation we require additional information. For this reason, we request that you respond to the items and questions attached to this letter. We cannot process your waiver requests until the information is received.

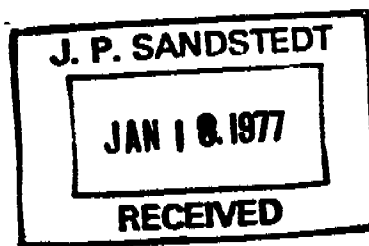

Items Relating to Waiver Request

Waiver Request 3 (Compliance with Section 61.64 (d)):

Enumerate and identify:

- (a) blend tanks and associated vents, and
- (b) exhaust streams from loading/unloading assemblies.

Waiver Request 7 (Compliance with Section 61.64 (c), 61.65 (b) (6)):

Enumerate and identify the various equipment components in VC service.

Waiver Request 8 (Compliance with Section 61.65 (b) (9)):

Enumerate and identify the following:

- (a) Reactor OC and header wash
- (b) Carbon absorber condensate
- (c) Miscellaneous recovery area
- (d) Slurry stripper condensate
- (e) Water wash column blowdown
- (f) Vessel clearing
- (g) Gas holder
- (h) Loading area
- (i) Slurry strainer

Does the above list include all the inprocess wastewater streams?
