All various views will be aired at the meeting on February 2 at Kettering Laboratories here in Cincinnati, to which I am inviting you to attend. The meeting will begin at 9 AM in Kehoe Auditorium. There will be a number of individuals coming purposely to discuss asbestos, among them Dr. Stan Roach from the London School of Hygiene, who will put up a case for changing the Crisotile limit. From comments I have received since the promulgation of the Notice of Intent, I gain the impression that the statement on asbestos change will be modified.
