ASBESTOS-RELATED MEDICAL CONDITION

Reference: A. B. Palmer to T. W. Hanavan and B. W. Karrh, 2/28.

The Guidelines for Management of Chronic Occupational Illnesses require verification of the diagnosis by appropriate medical specialists who also determine the degree of disability, if any. When an employee refuses specialist evaluation necessary to establish a diagnosis, site management cannot verify the diagnosis nor determine the degree of disability present.

Medical Division concurs that without specialist evaluation site management should not accept responsibility for the causation of the illness, determine the degree of disability, nor enter the case on the OSHA log.
