Re: Renovation Notification

Dear Mr. Bell:

This is to notify you, as required by 40 CFR 61.146, that Union Carbide Corporation, Old Ridgebury Road, Danbury, Connecticut 06817, as owner, plans to engage in renovation activities as described below:

Approximately 300 linear feet of insulation will be removed from a steam line to Building 15 from the distribution header at 3301 5th Avenue South, Texas City, Texas 77590. The equipment is over 30 years old.

Removal of the insulation is scheduled to start on June 20, 1988, with completion on June 27, 1988. All asbestos containing material will be removed using the glove bagging procedure. The insulation will be sealed in properly labeled impermeable plastic bags prior to removal from the area. Procedures to be employed during removal, clean-up, and disposal will conform to the requirements in 40 CFR 61.147 and 61.152.

All asbestos containing materials removed will be disposed at Gulf Coast Waste Disposal Authority, Loop 197, Texas City, Texas.
