Just to make sure I'm doing my math correctly, will the amended date for the WOTUS rule depend on when the current process on changing the date end?

In other words, if the process that was posted in the Federal Register on Nov. 22 comes to an end, say, on February 5, 2018, then the amended effective date for WOTUS would be February 5, 2020. Is that correct?
