Dear Mr. Conrad:

Mr. J. C. Fryman of our Bakelite Company has requested that we send you toxicity information on the above. Our toxicity work on this product is limited because of the difficulty in administering a material of this type to animals. Nevertheless, we have done enough work to demonstrate that it is of a very low order of toxicity and is not a skin irritant.

Below is a brief summary of our work:

Repeated dose to rats in the diet
28 days at 10 % in the diet (10.4 grams per kilogram per day) had no effect.

Primary irritation, rabbit belly vesicant test
20% solution in ethyl ether gave only trace of capillary injection.

Eye injury to rabbits
10% solution in deodorized kerosene caused no injury.
