4 A Starting at "all linings"?

5 Q Where it says "when riveting".

6 A Okay. When riveting A or double A brake
7 shoe linings to brake shoes, it is very important that
8 the side of the lining which carries the trademark be
9 placed next to the shoe so to ensure the ground side
10 of the lining being next to the drum.

11 All linings should be ground after
12 assembling to shoe so as to secure a uniform braking
13 surface.

14 Q Now, as you read that, do you agree that
15 that states that the brake linings for the Model A was
16 meant to be ground?

17 A Oh, the Model A linings, no question about
18 that.

19 Q No question about that?

20 A That is correct.
