Please be advised that you have successfully participated in the Visible Emissions Certification conducted in Jackson, Mississippi, by the Office of Pollution Control on April 23 - 25, 2003. You met the following standards as specified in the November 12, 1974, issue of the Federal Register (Volume 39, No. 219, Method):

1. Maintained an average deviation of less than 7.5% for a set of 25 white and 25 black smoke readings.
2. Did not have any one reading with a deviation greater than 15%.

The deviations for your qualifying run, Run No. 24-1W were:

White Smoke: 5.6
Black Smoke: 3.4

Your certification will expire on October 25, 2003.
