

US REGULATIONS

OSHA ASBESTOS STANDARDS:

GENERAL INDUSTRY STANDARD, 29CFR 1910.1001

Applies to:

- All occupational exposures not covered under the construction and maritime standards activities
- Includes Automotive Brake Technicians and Custodial Workers (where no active asbestos related work is ongoing)

MARITIME STANDARD, 29CFR 1915.1001

Applies to:

- Cable-laying ship workers

CONSTRUCTION STANDARD, 29CFR 1926.1101

Applies to:

- Most of the asbestos related work activities common to AT&T operations
- Installers, Maintenance, Operations, HVAC Maintenance, Technicians, Custodial
- Renovations (or demolitions) involving asbestos containing building components
- Removal of asbestos containing materials
- Encapsulation or repairs of asbestos containing materials
- Installing other materials where asbestos will be disturbed
- Emergency cleanup of small asbestos fiber releases
- Working where you contact asbestos containing materials, but do not disturb them
- The transportation, disposal, storage, containment and housekeeping activities involving asbestos containing products at locations where other asbestos construction activities are being performed.
