

1 asbestos exposure with asbestosis was published in the
2 United Kingdom in 1907.

3 Scattered case reports of carcinoma, in
4 persons occupationally exposed to asbestos, began
5 appearing in the literature in the 1930s.

6 Ford cannot state when a Ford employee first
