Federal - New Bill

H.R. 2752 To encourage the prevention of water pollution by allowing amounts paid for industrial waste treatment works to be amortized at an accelerated rate for income-tax purposes. By Mr. Simpson (Pa.). To Committee on Ways and Means Feb. 19. p. 1429

ARIZONA S.117 Water Pollution. Referred to Public Health in Senate Feb. 24; referred to Planning-Development in Senate Feb. 24.

ARKANSAS H.112 Water Pollution. Reported with amendment in House Feb. 22; re-committed to Calendar in House Feb. 23; passed House Feb. 26; referred to Calendar in Senate Feb. 26.

NEW MEXICO H.362 Poisonous Drugs. Reported favorably in House Feb. 23.

Note: This bill, which lists both "salts of lead" and "salts of zinc" among the poisons whose sale is to be restricted, appears to be so all-inclusive that the public sale of such products as lead or zinc paints would require a permit from the State Health Department. The Association's opposition has been registered through appropriate channels and copies of the bill have been sent to those of our members whose interests seem most directly affected. VERMONT S.34 Water Pollution. Reported favorably in Senate March 1.

WASHINGTON H.455 Air Pollution. Reported favorably in House Feb. 24. Passed House Feb. 27. Referred to Medicine-Fentistry in Senate Feb. 28.

MARYLAND S.264 Water Pollution. Relating to water pollution control. To Agriculture & Natural Resources March 1.

MASSACHUSETTS H.2143 Water Supplies. Making further provision for the protection of public water supplies. To Water Supply Feb. 6.

MISSOURI S.472 Smoke Regulation. To amend S9.07 (27) of the statutes, relating to smoke regulation. To State and Local Government Feb. 26.
