TULLER AND MOOSMAN,

J. H. Stutt, accompanied by the writer, met William Moosman in the New York Office Tuesday, February 28th, Mr. Moosman being accompanied by his attorney, Mr. Philip Novick. Tuller and Moosman's complaint was again thoroughly threshed out, and for the first time Moosman definitely mentioned the amount of his claim which he states is \$2,900.

We intimated that a settlement for this amount would be entirely out of the question, and we might consider a fifty-fifty settlement if the claim was not in excess of \$2,000. Mr. Novick has promised to talk the matter over with his client, and he will get in touch with the writer in the next day or two.

We believe it will be necessary to settle this claim for \$1,000, and in view of our material being somewhat at fault, we are convinced that this will be a cheap way out for us.

In view of the possibility of an early settlement, we suggest no action be taken on liening the building until further advised by the writer.
