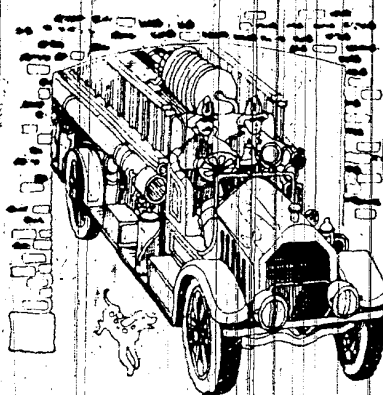


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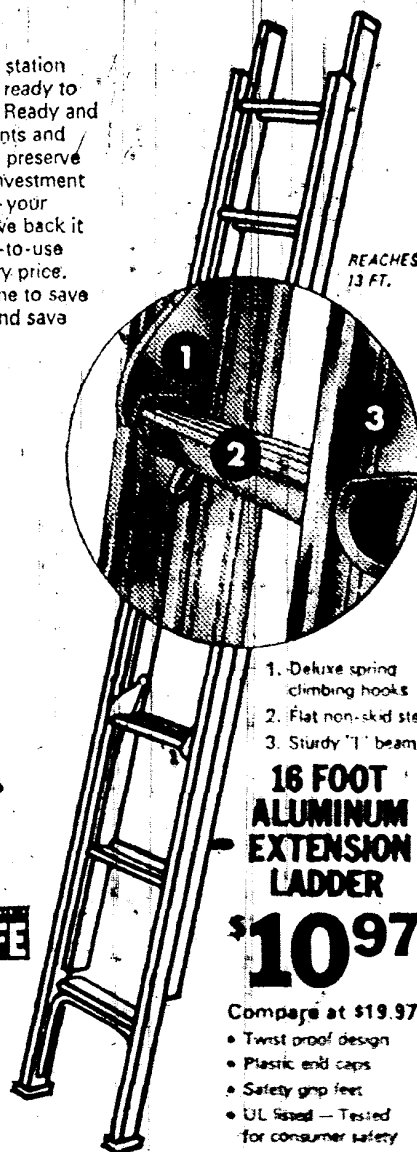

Botulism Victim Dies

BAKERSFIELD (UPI) — One of six persons stricken with botulism after eating tainted chili pepper sauce died late Wednesday night. Three others remained in critical condition.

Hospital spokesmen said Juan Vega, 18, died at 11:40 p.m.

Vega, Desi Vega, 28, Martin Castro, 18, and Benito Montiel, 23, had been under respirators since the first of the week after contracting the food poisoning which attacks the central nervous system.

Emergency tracheotomies operations which open a passage in the throat, had also been performed on the four to ease their breathing.

Two others, Catalina Montiel, 46, and Albino Montiel, 45, were released Wednesday evening, after showing rapid improvement and a seventh person, Robert Montiel, 29, was released Tuesday after test indicated he did not have the botulism.

Catalina Montiel served the homemade chili sauce at Saturday night dinner after adding spices and tomatoes because it smelled strange.

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
