It would seem to be a good idea to withhold Dr. Schradin's visit to Drs. Thompson or Miller until we have more information on them. This we can easily get by writing to other medical sources in Los Angeles.

In the meantime, we may consider ways and means of having [REDACTED] consult Dr. Cullen Irish (age 45), who has been highly recommended to us as a neuro-psychiatrist and who is practicing in Los Angeles. It may be that this can be maneuvered through Wagner, Murdock or their associates. If this does not proceed as we would have it, I think that because of the importance of the situation that we could seriously consider one of us looking into the matter personally and spending sometime with [REDACTED] in the fall.
