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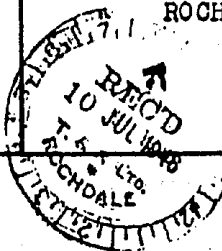

Asbestosis Case - J.Greensmith, deceased.

We regret to inform you that Mr. J. Greensmith, who has been a Partial Disablement Compensation case since June 1944, died on the 6th. inst. and an inquest was held in Leeds to-day. This was attended by Mr. Collins of Jackson & Co. who will no doubt be reporting on the proceedings, the verdict being to the effect that death was due to a primary cancer of the Peritoneum, and the Medical evidence stating that the mild Asbestosis present was not a contributory factor. It therefore appears that there can be no claim on behalf of the dependents.

We enclose a schedule giving details of Greensmith's service, and the Compensation he has received, the payment of which has now ceased.

We have also sent particulars to the Insurance Company.
