Thank you for talking with me on the telephone yesterday. To review our conversation, last Friday I visited the Baldwin-Lima-Hamilton Corporation, which uses your product. They use your product in the open air without the benefit of paint spray booths.

They use your wash primer, consisting of 85% resin and 15% acid, Spec Mil C-15328, 195 acid. They also use your primer TTP-636 red oxide.

I would like to have information on the various constituents of your wash primer. Incidentally, I found the pH of your acid constituent was about 8 - on the alkaline side. Was I correct? I would also like to have the composition of both the pigment and the vehicle in your red oxide paint.
