OBJECTIVE

Introductory call on regular user of RG-144.

OBSERVATIONS

No problems with our product. 1974 usage should exceed 1973 demands but no estimate of how much. 144 being used to produce Thixseal, a Baker thixotrope containing a wax of some type. Compounded by Middlesex Chemical in Somerville, NJ. None used at Bayonne.

Discussed warning labels which apparently Baker has not used in the past. Kent is in the process of having one printed which, in agreement with their lawyer, will cover the OSHA regulations.

As soon as the mixing equipment at Middlesex Chemical has been repaired, they would like us to run a dust count for them. This has been discussed in the past and I agreed to have it run when convenient for all.

Baker is going through a big reorganization. Are to be known as Industrial Chemical Division of National Lead. Will be headed by Carl Moore, a V.P. of National Lead. A large number of personnel changes are taking effect and Kent feels that it may touch him.

ACTION

None at this time. However, because of the personnel changes going on it is felt that routine calls should be made in order to keep a pulse on the situation.
