The following comments are for your consideration in answering Degussa's letter dated 1-27-72.

- R 1 - Degussa did not discredit the activities of UCC but they did discredit A-14 and A-28. This impedes the progress of another UCC distributor for moving the same products under different names.
- R 2 - Degussa should also advise their U.S., Japan, and other representatives not to discredit our products. Dr. Fratzscher made a tie between A-28 and RG-244 when he "Discredited" both of them in Japan.
- R 3 - Asbestos is proven to be harmful only when TLV's are exceeded for 10-30 years.

General- A list of customers "in due time" is not adequate - our new distributor (W. R. Grace) needs them now so they can squelch Degussa's comments.

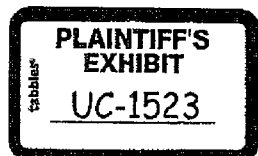
If they became so concerned late in 1971 why didn't they request our assistance and/or advise us of their intentions before taking customer action?
