We mention the chronic reference dose in the attached *Human-Health Assessment Scoping Document in Support of Registration Review*. It appears in Table 4 on page 22.

The RfD is an estimate of the quantity of chemical that a person could be exposed to every day for the rest of their life with no appreciable risk of adverse health effects. The reference dose is typically measured in milligrams (mg) of chemical per kilogram (kg) of body weight per day.
