Item 13291 - RAW MATERIALS

Lithopone - Mr. Lemperly to report on advisability of dropping Enamelastic in view of the Lithopone shortage and substituting No. 39 Enamel.

Turpentine - Mr. Hennig to report on progress in buying Memphis Turpentine.

Antimony Oxide Black - Mr. Lemperly to report on whether firm orders for materials containing this were received and later cancelled. If so, claims are to be placed immediately on prime contractor.
