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S - T - A - R - T

Safety Training and Accident Reduction Techniques

WHAT IS S-T-A-R-T?

S-T-A-R-T is a title of a plantwide safety program made from the first letters of the following words: Safety Training in Accident Reduction Techniques. So, S-T-A-R-T is an accident reduction training program.

IS THE S-T-A-R-T PROGRAM A SLIDE PROGRAM?

No! Slides can be and are used to show examples where lack of safety awareness can lead to injuries. Improvements in safety awareness that avoid the scenes shown will result in lower injury rates. Slides are one way to increase awareness. There are many others.

IS THE S-T-A-R-T PROGRAM ONLY FOR CRAFTSMEN AND OPERATORS?

The S-T-A-R-T Program is aimed at improving safety awareness as a part of the jobs we do every day. It is aimed at improving our ability to recognize hazards so we can avoid them every day.

IS S-T-A-R-T A ONE SHOT, FLASH-IN-THE-PAN SAFETY PROGRAM?

No, it is a continuing program to help us recognize acts or conditions which could lead to injury. Current emphasis: USING CORRECT PROCEDURES.

HOW DOES S-T-A-R-T FIT IN WITH THE OVERALL SAFETY PROGRAM?

The injuries we have suffered in 1981 appear to have a common cause--- LACK OF SAFETY AWARENESS rather than failure of equipment, processes or other causes.

S-T-A-R-T in the usual sense means to make a new beginning--it means the same thing in making an improvement in safety awareness.

We've done better before, now is the time to make a NEW BEGINNING to look, be sharp, be safe. Let's keep the good things going!

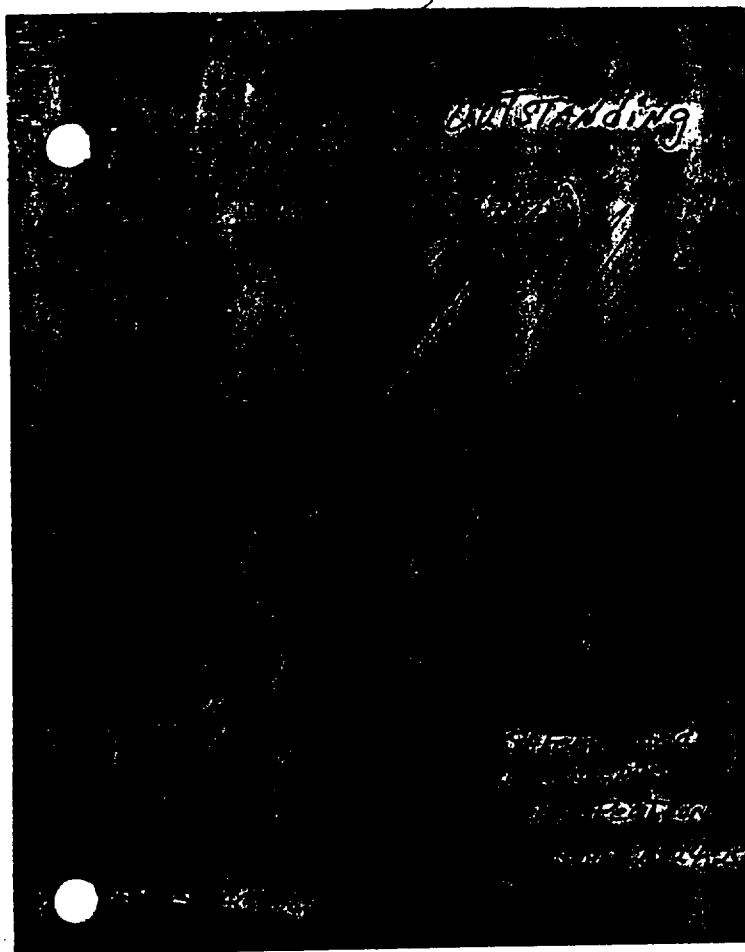
