It was Dazian's, too, that built the symmetrical that added two and a half inches to the calf of one of John Barrymore's legs, when he appeared on Broadway in tights in "The Jest." The great Mansfield wore symmetricals, and almost every other actor whose legs did not measure up to the standards of the day.

The man who had the most to do with these symmetricals, and who is president of Dazian's to-day is Emil Friedlander, a tall, easy to talk to man with graying hair and laugh-wrinkles about his eyes.

He has spent 42 years in the business of costing shows for Broadway and Hollywood produc-tions, and the walls of his office, at 142 West 44th street, have grown into a sort of museum of mementos of great epics and times in the theater.

In one frame are two cancelled checks—one for \$50,000 left by the late Henry Dazian himself to the Actors' Fund of America, and another for \$90,000, donated to medical research. . . In all, Dazian left more than two million dollars to medical research, and if you care to glance through the direc-tories you will find the name of the research fund that bears Daz-ian's name.

Emil Friedlander has one of Sarah Bernhardt's slippers, a frag-ile, tiny thing of pink satin made by Meier of Paris, who, according to the legend in the slipper also made shoes for the Queen of Eng-land. He has personal notes from Belasco framed on the wall, which begged Mr. Dazian not to let the details of Belasco's new shows be-come a subject for gossip in the cafes of Paris.

Field Open for Women Chemists

BERKELEY, April 24 (AP) — Women with only elementary training in chemistry now are in demand in industrial plants, and even those without any chemistry instruction whatever can qualify for jobs this fall by studying throughout the summer, Dr. Wendell M. Latimer, of the University of California said today.

Dr. Latimer, dean of the college of chemistry, said in the bay area 50 jobs paying \$150 to \$170 a month would be open to women chemists. To fill these jobs ade-quately, he added, they should have five courses.

However, three elementary courses can make it possible for a student to meet the requirements, he said. These courses will be available at the intersession and summer session on the Berkeley campus.
