Complains of anorexia and lassitude. Denies neurologic symptomatology, abdominal pains of any sort, constipation. Neither he nor his family or friends has noticed any pallor.

Physical

Weight loss of about 5 lbs. in the last month. Weight had been stable for the past year at least.

Laboratory

Monthly stipple counts have shown no stipple cells.
Monthly hemoglobin determinations have shown a Hgb. remaining around 90% ----- present value 85%

Rule out excessive lead absorption.
