2 Q Towards the end in May of 1990 what could he
3 physically do for himself?

4 A He couldn't do much for anything. I never
5 forget my mother telling me that she had to put my
6 father on his back and crawl to the bathroom.

7 There wasn't a whole lot he could do. Lay
8 in bed and sit up a little bit and lay down. That was
9 about it.

10 He wasn't eating. His eliminations weren't
11 there, and there was concern about the eliminations
12 because it would cause bowel stoppage because the pain
13 medication was so strong, it helps back up part of the
14 urinary and the bowel system, so the question was
15 enemas, what can you do to deal with this.

16 He just wasted away.

17 Q When was the last time that you saw your dad
18 alive?

19 A I saw my dad alive either the Thursday or
20 Friday before Saturday, May 26th when he passed.

21 Q He passed on May 26th?
