Thank you for your letter of September 20 with regard to our manuscript "Experimental Studies of Asbestosis."

We trust, Page, that you will be able to wait until such time as the reprints are available, as we do not wish to jeopardize in any way the publication of the paper in the Archives of Industrial Hygiene and Occupational Medicine. We mention this fact because of an unfortunate experience with a paper that was given at the Sixth Saranac Symposium on Beryllium. Although all the papers of that meeting should have been published first in the proceedings of the Symposium, one author happened to lend his paper for private review and then learned it had been abstracted and published in a technical journal without his permission. These things do happen and, since the publication of the asbestos manuscript is promised within the next few months, we would prefer to postpone with distribution of the paper until after it has appeared in the Archives.

We are wondering just how many reprints you will require, as we must submit our order within the next week.
