Good to hear the webinar will be attended by a large number of participants. We will mainly listen in to the meeting, so don't expect having to answer much questions from our side.

We indeed discussed the pre-publication of our dossier with ECHA. They are open to it, so we expect that we will have our dossier pre-published. We don't have an exact date yet, but I expect this to be shortly before the conformity check will start (presumably early February).

No guarantees on this however, as final decisions on this still have to be taken.

Regarding your question on splitting up of the consultation: this will depend on the lessons learnt from the FFF dossier. This will be up to ECHA, but of course we will discuss this with them. This is something we will communicate when there is agreement on this.

I hope this email finds you well. I noticed that 3 of you from RIVM will join the Fluoropolymers Product Group panel discussions this Thursday. I will be moderating the first panel and [REDACTED] (FPG) will moderate the second one. We have over 500 persons registered and will have the Zoom Q&A chat open for questions. Those questions might not be answered on the day (as we have a packed agenda!) but we will take note of them and look to answer over the next few editions of the FPG Newsletter and via the LinkedIn group.

If you recall, when we had a meeting online a month or two ago I asked that following the 5CA submission to ECHA in January does the Agency plan to make it public shortly after? E.g. it would be published before conformity check, which would then give stakeholders more time to prepare their consultation responses. Likewise, do you know if ECHA intends to split the consultation deadlines? E.g. initial deadline, and then the final official deadline after 6 months? This is something they did with the firefighting foams restriction.
