SUBJ: EXPERIMENTAL SAMPLES EMERGENCY INFORMATION

Recent new product development work has resulted in multiple occurrences of bulk shipments of "experimental products" being shipped. Spent Caustic and KOTO are examples of this. The problem from a CTIRP standpoint is that these products probably aren't entered into COEDS, where DOT information is found, and typically an MSDS may not be readily available by virtue of it having had limited distribution, typically the "researcher" and the customer. In other words, the Safety Directors, or CTIRP responder, may not have the information. We need to discuss this situation at our next committee meeting.
