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FLICAST STORAGE

The storage of Plicast materials is governed by the same procedures that would apply to hydraulic cement. It should be stored in a dry, warm room preferably on a raised, slatted, wood platform so that no moisture is present. Ordinarily a storage period of 1 year is the maximum and Plicast materials should be used within that time. If storage has been for a longer period the materials may still be satisfactory but a 10 lb. sample should be submitted to our laboratory for test. We have usually found that the mechanical strength is lowered by longer storage than 1 year,
