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Recent data from Dr. J. P. Mieure's work indicates the presence of naphthalene in biphenyl and anthracene or phenanthrene and dibenzofuran in Santowax R used in the manufacture of Aroclors.

The naphthalene, anthracene or phenanthrene could be present in the benzene used in the diphenyl unit or could be co-produced with the biphenyl, terphenyl and quaterphenyl.

The dibenzofuran could result from oxygen containing contaminants in the benzene or, more likely, be formed because of the presence of the promoter, acetone.

The Anniston Plant should design and execute a program for determining the source or sources of these contaminants.

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
