Seven (7) KEWANEE portable, double pass, down draft, self-contained smokeless riveted steel boilers built according to maximum requirements of the A.S.M.E. Code for 100# steam working pressure to be subjected to hydrostatic test pressure of 160# and with lap welded mild steel fire tubes and complete with castings for erecting on brick ash pit bases as shown by the job plans and as contemplated by paragraphs 1006 and 1007 of job specifications; also paragraphs 20 to 38 inclusive, pages 2 and 3, of standard Treasury Department specifications dated April 1, 1928 made a part of the job specifications by paragraph 1005 of job specifications including double side swinging center hinged parallel opening fuel doors.

Trimmings for each boiler as covered by par. 1012 and 1014 of job specifications but not including any pipe or fittings for attaching such trimmings to the boilers.

Tools as covered by par. 1013 of job specifications.

Blow-off tank with manhole and such threaded flanges and tappings as are shown on the job plan to comply with par. 1015 of job specifications except that we do not furnish supports, platform, ladders or any fixtures of any kind for attachment to the tank.

Drip tank 72" in diameter 18' long as shown on the job plans and as described in par. 1028 of job specifications including manhole, threaded flanges and tappings required but we do not furnish any part of platform or supports for this tank nor any valves, fixtures or fittings such as are mentioned in par. 1028, 1029 and 1030 of job specifications.

The price hereinafter extended includes all the above material, freight prepaid to Washington, boilers unloaded from the cars, hauled to the building, and erected on foundations you will furnish complete or on blocks if that may be your choice. All doors and castings pertaining to the boilers included in the quotation will be properly attached to the boilers except that the grates will not

be put in place but they will be put in the boiler room where you may direct. We do not purpose attaching any trimmings nor will we do any pipe work.

The steel breeching will be furnished according to the job plans for connecting the seven boilers with the masonry flue and the breeching complete with hangers, expansion joints, multiple dampers with adjustable levers or quadrants will be furnished, freight and cartage paid to the building site and erected in place, all in accordance with par. 1017 and 1018 of the job specifications and the job plans.

On all the foregoing material and serviced- - - - - \$39,900.00

We do not furnish any insulation nor masonry materials nor put in place any of that material in connection with the boilers or breeching.

To erect the seven boilers according to the plan and the job specifications you will require above the floor or pit line for ash pit bases, for bridge walls at the rear of the lower grates and for baffle walls on top of water grate drum a total of 11,500 common brick and 3000 common size fire brick. The outside surface of all the boilers to be covered is 3800 sq. ft.

This quotation is submitted for acceptance within thirty days after award of contract by the government to the general contractor on bids to be opened on the advertised date March 27th. We will deliver and erect the boilers as herein proposed within sixty days after you notify us to do so and we will furnish and erect the breeching as herein proposed within sixty days after you tell us to do so.

Our proposal includes the hauling and delivering of the blow-off and drip tanks at the building site but not installed in place in the boiler room.

Terms of payment are \$30,000.00 within sixty days from date of complete shipment of equipment from our factory here; balance of \$9,900.00

Delivery within thirty days after we have completed delivery and services herein proposed.

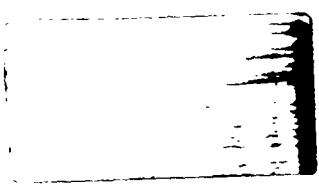

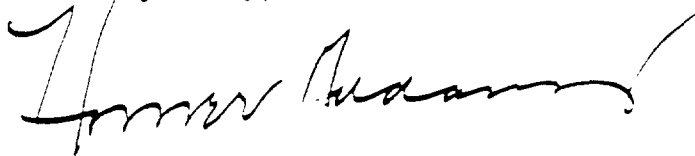
Beg to acknowledge yours of May 3rd and have again carefully gone over this matter, to make sure my former understanding, as reflected by remittance to you, is right.

My copy of contract designates, among the dates on which installments are payable, May 1st, 1922, \$6862.51 together with interest on each of the said installments from January 1st, 1922, until the payment of the installment, payable quarterly, at the rate of 6% per annum.

I therefore understand that the interest on the whole amount unpaid, is due quarterly after January 1st and respectively on April 1st, July 1st and October 1st, but for any installments falling due between these interest dates, the accrued interest, with such due installment, is to be paid you with said installment remittance.

Will you kindly compare the above explanation with the text of contract you have and advise me further, if we are still apart in our understanding.

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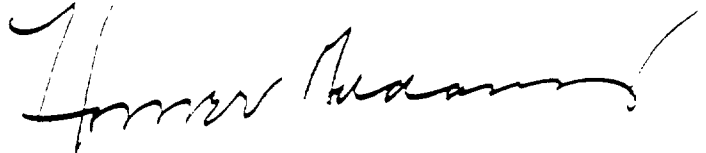
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
