

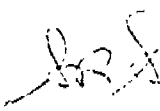

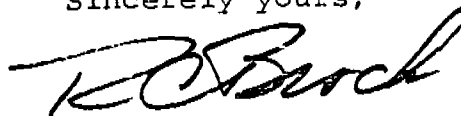
Gentlemen:

SUBJECT: PROCEDURES FOR FOOD AND
DRUG CHEMICALS, FOOD GRADE
MATERIALS & WARRANTY FORMS

1. The purpose of this bulletin is to outline our procedures for Food and Drug Chemicals.
2. Our operations should be in accord with applicable parts of the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act, Amendments to the FDC Act, Federal Regulations and similar state laws and regulations.
3. Procedures for plant registration and inspections are covered in PPM 4QP10.
4. Good Manufacturing Practices for Drugs form part of the FDC Act. Similar regulations for foods were published in the Federal Register on April 26, 1969. Copies may be obtained from Morristown Chemical Control.
5. Food and drug products will be designated as such on the Manufacturing Specification by including the following terms with the product name:

Drugs: U.S.P., N.F., FD & C and D&C Color Additives or drug grade

Foods: Food Grade, Food Chemicals Codex Grade or FD & C Color Additives.
6. For products so designated the District Sales Manager may sign for customers an FDA guaranty letter in the form attached hereto. Before a guaranty letter can be issued for other products, the proper specification must be established.
7. Operating guidelines should be established by each applicable location. Chemical Control should be consulted when necessary and will conduct periodic inspections.

GUARANTY UNDER SECTIONS 303 (c) (2) and c (3) OF THE FEDERAL FOOD, DRUG, and COSMETIC ACT

Gentlemen:

For the purposes of Section 303 (c) (2) of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act, we hereby guarantee that, as of the date of each shipment by us to you of any article listed below such article is not, when shipped adulterated or misbranded within the meaning of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act or of any applicable state law in which the definitions of adulteration and misbranding are the same as those contained in the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act. We further guarantee that, as of the date of each shipment, no such article is an article which may not, under the provisions of Section 404 or 505 of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act, be introduced into interstate commerce.

If any article listed below is a color additive, we further guarantee, pursuant to Section 303 (c) (3) of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act, that such color additive is from a batch certified in accordance with the applicable regulations promulgated under said act.

This guaranty shall, however, be void and of no effect in any instance where the particular use by you of any article to which this guaranty would otherwise apply is a use which is not in accordance with the requirements of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act of applicable state laws.

This guaranty shall be a continuing guaranty and shall continue in effect for a period of five years from the date hereof, or until such earlier date as you shall receive from us written notice of the revocation of the guaranty contained herein.
