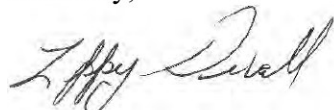
On behalf of the American Farm Bureau Federation, the nation's largest general farm organization, I am writing to invite you to participate in a special meeting we will host later this year.
