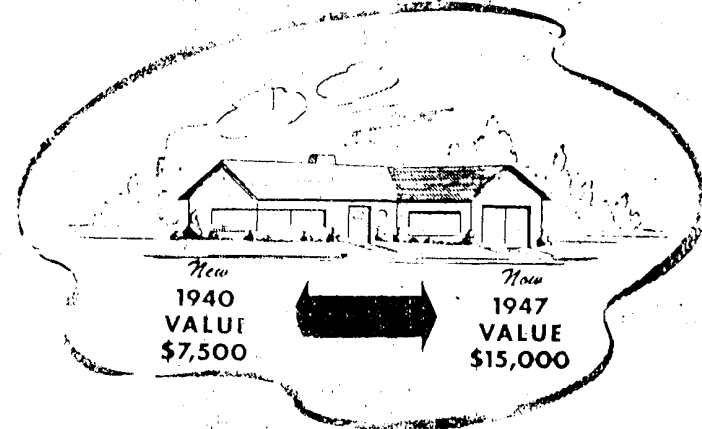
Caravan to traverse old El Camino Real
