Has been well all of life till March 1928 - when one day - 20 min. after starting truck was seized with vertigo, dimness of vision and weakness as result of exhaust fumes in cab which were frequently very heavy. Recovered 30 min. after leaving cab. In 1929, & 1930 attacks recurred at frequent intervals without any association with or exposure to exhaust gas. Headache was pronounced symptom in 1920 - for one period during Sept. last three weeks without relief. There has been occasional dimness vision and feeling fullness in ears - questionable heterophopia. No chills, fever or rashes. No localized neurological symptoms. Bowels have moved 10-12 x? day for past 3 years green watery stools - no tenesmus. Frequent lower abdominal pain.

Physical findings aside from fever and undernutrition and ~~the~~ evidence of infection on the teeth and tonsils, are essentially negative. It is the impression that all of this man's symptoms and physical findings can be explained by the chronic
