AN OSHA COMPLIANCE OFFICER VISITED THE TEXAS CITY PLANT ON FRIDAY AFTERNOON, MARCH 18, TO INSPECT THE MAINTENANCE LOCKER ROOM AREA OF BUILDING 74 IN ANSWER TO AN EMPLOYEE COMPLAINT. THE COMPLAINT STATED THAT EMPLOYEES HAD TO TAKE THEIR REST BREAKS IN THE LOCKER ROOM AT SUCH TIMES THAT A MEETING WAS IN PROGRESS IN THE CONFERENCE - LUNCH ROOM WHICH COULD RESULT IN AN UNSANITARY SITUATION.

THE C.O. INSPECTED THE FACILITY AND PRIVATELY QUESTIONED TWO HOURLY EMPLOYEES INCLUDING THE UNION REPRESENTATIVE. IN THE CLOSING CONFERENCE HE STATED THAT HE FOUND NO VIOLATIONS OF OSHA STANDARDS ALTHOUGH HE DID SUGGEST THAT WASTE CONTAINERS BE KEPT COVERED.

NO CITATION IS ANTICIPATED FROM THIS INSPECTION.
