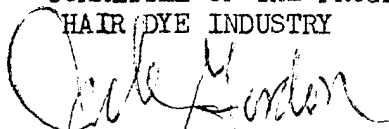
However, our petition will be submitted to you for your approval and will confine itself to the facts as stated in your report.
