The volumes of air breathed by L. Daroczy and Josef Svetlik, in one minute, are 9.50 liters and 6.14 liters, respectively. These values are the averages of several determinations after an initial period of resting and becoming accustomed to the mask.

We have additional pulmonary and renal function tests on all three subjects in their files. The tests indicate normal renal and pulmonary function in all three subjects.

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
