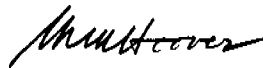

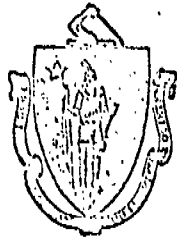

RESOLVE

providing for an investigation and study by a special commission of the possible presence of cancer producing ingredients in packaged goods.

Resolved, That a special commission, to consist of two members of the senate, three members of the house of representatives, the commissioner of public health or his designee, three persons to be appointed by the governor, is hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation and study of the components of all packaged goods of whatever nature and kind whether in cases, bottles or cartons sold or distributed in the commonwealth with particular reference to cancer producing ingredients.
