Confirming our conversation, it appears that "Forane", which is iso-flurane, is replacing enflurane and halothane in the anesthetic gas market. We have had calls requesting us to analyze Forane in our analytical service. To assure we do not deal with another "methylene chloride" type of compound, could you validate an analytical procedure for Forane. If it looks straightforward to analyze, we will suggest to Marketing that this compound could be added to our list of compounds for which the 3510 could be analyzed if the market opportunity justifies it.
