Dear Dr. Kehoe:

Vitol will go on sale to the public in Columbus on September 15, 1948 in accordance with our previous plans. During the week of September 19th or as soon thereafter as you wish, I will be glad to accompany you or your representative in arranging for examinations of key people engaged in handling Vitol in Columbus.

Since my last visit with you, the Standard Oil Company (Ohio) expressed a strong desire to participate in our merchandising effort and we granted their request to help in the promotion and sale of Vitol. All three of the participating oil companies in Columbus (The Shell Oil Company, The Standard Oil Company (Ohio) and The Pure Oil Company) have agreed to cooperate fully with you in determining and controlling potential toxicological hazards.

Our two Sales Divisions through which the Vitameter is being sold in Columbus have expressed a desire to have their District Managers' cars equipped with a Vitameter and furnished Vitol for its use. It would be expedient for us to furnish them the device along with a case of 24 one-quart cans of Vitol.
